

Aster sets a new Guinness World Record Orabetes





Taking tender care of the little ones #AsterVolunteersTreatmentAid

Aster Sick Kids (ASK) Foundation, Aster Volunteers, and Aster Medcity in association with Lions Club Palakkad conducted a free multi-specialty pediatric screening for the natives of Palakkad at Mercy College. The medical was team led by Dr. Sajan Koshy (Pediatric Cardiac surgeon), Dr. Bijesh (Cardiology), Dr. Geetha Mammayil (Pediatric Gastroenterology), Dr. Parvathy L (Pediatric Endocrinology), Dr. Irshad M (Pediatrics) Dr.Akhil S.R (Orthopedics), and Dr. Dinesh D Menon (Neurosurgery) from Aster Medcity.

The camp successfully screened **64 children**. Further surgeries were suggested for 3 heart and 5 orthopedic cases. With ASK Foundation's support, 19 cases were referred for detailed screening.
