







Making Miracles Happen



In March 2023, we contributed more than INR 1 Crore+ towards 713 beneficiaries, helping them back to a healthy lifestyle.

As what was witnessed by Turkey and Syria is said to be the most anguishing natural catastrophes of recent times, the series of earthquake brought the countries to a standstill. Buildings collapsed and many lost lives.

Aster Volunteers joined forces with Emirates Red Crescent to provide relief to the affected victims by offering services in packaging and arranging over **15,000 relief kits**. Cementing our vision on a bigger humanitarian platform #DIHAD2023





The waste management plant in Brahmapuram, Ernakulam Districit in Kerala caught fire recently. The toxic haze from the garbage spread across surrounding areas causing health issues. As a part of the disaster management support, Aster Volunteers Mobile Medical Services Kochi, in association with the District Administration and District Magistrate Office (DMO) Ernakulam, organised a medical mission including Pulmonary Function Test (PFT) to support fume-affected victims.

Distributing kindness with Iftar food kits



As a part of the Kindness is a Habit initiative, for the month of April and the Holy Ramadan, Aster Pharmacy, along with Aster Volunteers and Dubai Police, continued the Iftar food kit distribution initiative like previous years to help people stuck in traffic break their fast. Aster Volunteers joins the forces to eradicate Tuberculosis (TB) #AsterVolunteersAid

Aster Volunteers pledged to the National TB Eradication campaign launched by the Prime Minister's Office India. The program aims to remove TB cases from India by 2025. Generally, children are the primary contacts sputum positive TB patients.

As a support to the initiative, in association with the TB eradication department of the Government of Kerala & Aster Labs Kerala, Aster DM Foundation will provide TB screening IGRA (Interferon Gamma Release Assay) free of cost to **500 children** aged between 5 and 15 at Ernakulam District, Kerala. We would like to offer our thanks to Mr. TJ Wilson, Executive Director for providing valuable guidelines and supporting the entire initiative.



BeFIRST - To Aid & Save Lives #AsterVolunteersCoach #BLSAwarenessTraining



To bring more discipline and engagement to the Basic Life Support (BLS) activities, Aster Medcity Kochi partnered with Rotary and Panchayats across Kerala to launch the BeFirst initiative on 13th August 2022.

As a part of the campaign, a 7-day long roadshow called Jeevitham covering 8 districts, and 45 locations in Kerala was successfully conducted. Recently we also celebrated our **100th BeFirst session**. From the start of the initiative, we have trained over **12,500 people** to be ready for immediate help during times of emergency.

We are committed to completing **225 episodes** by the first anniversary of BeFirst. We offer our heartfelt thanks to Ramasubramaniam A, Deputy Health Manager -Business Development, Aster Medcity Kochi, for leading the BeFirst initiative to a grand success under the leadership of Mr. Farhan Yasin, Regional Director -Aster Hospital Kerala & Oman.
