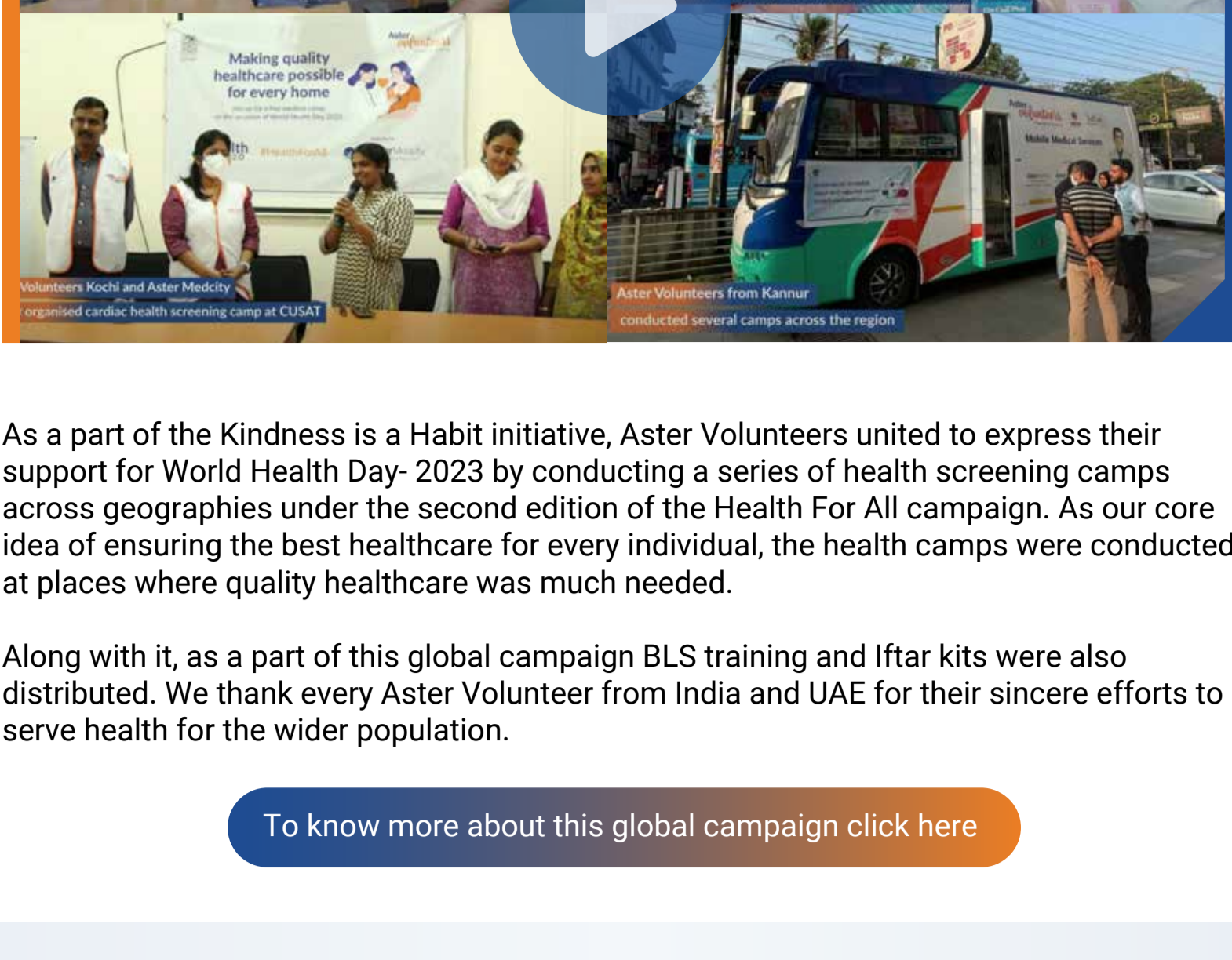


World Health Day- 2023 Global Campaign

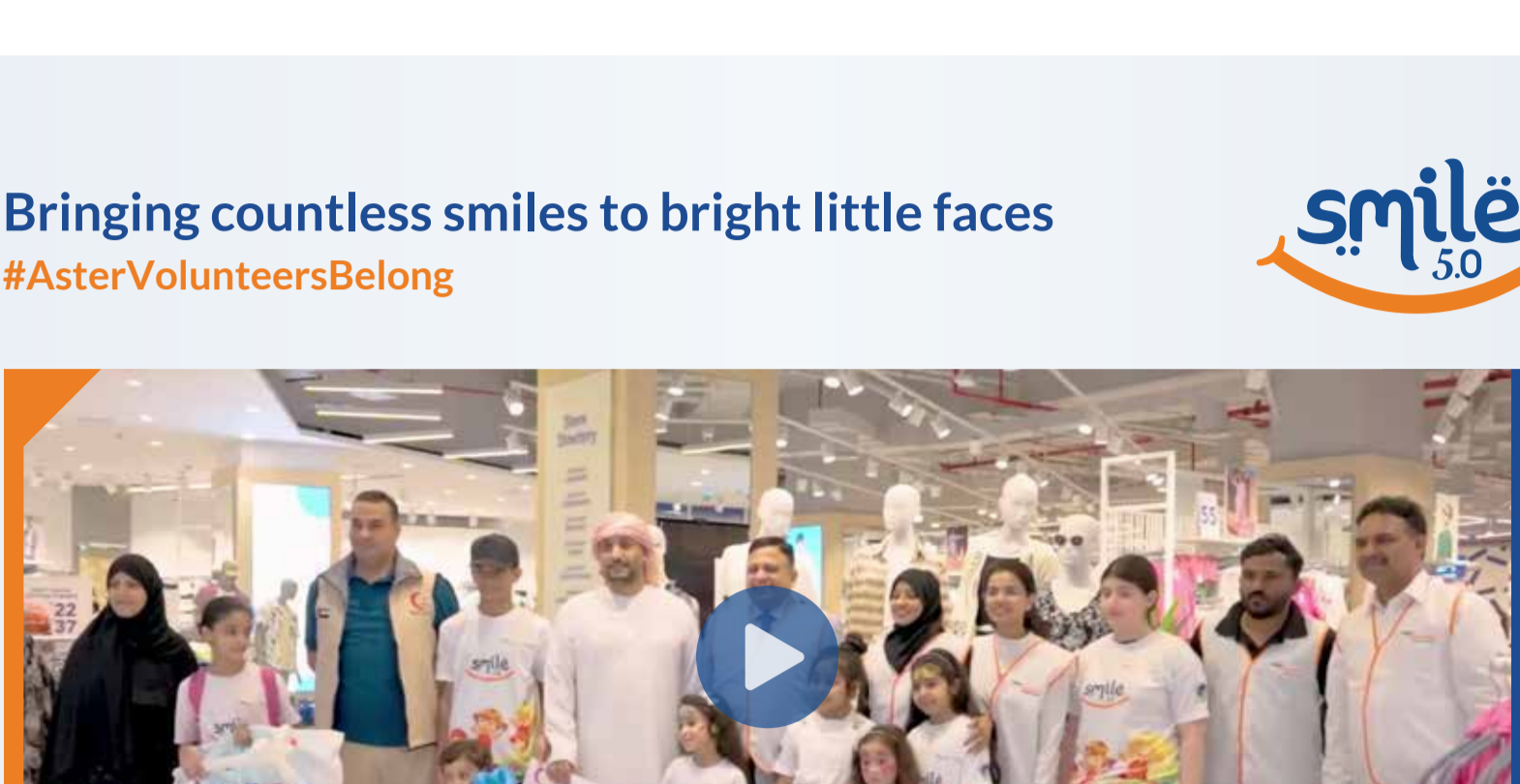

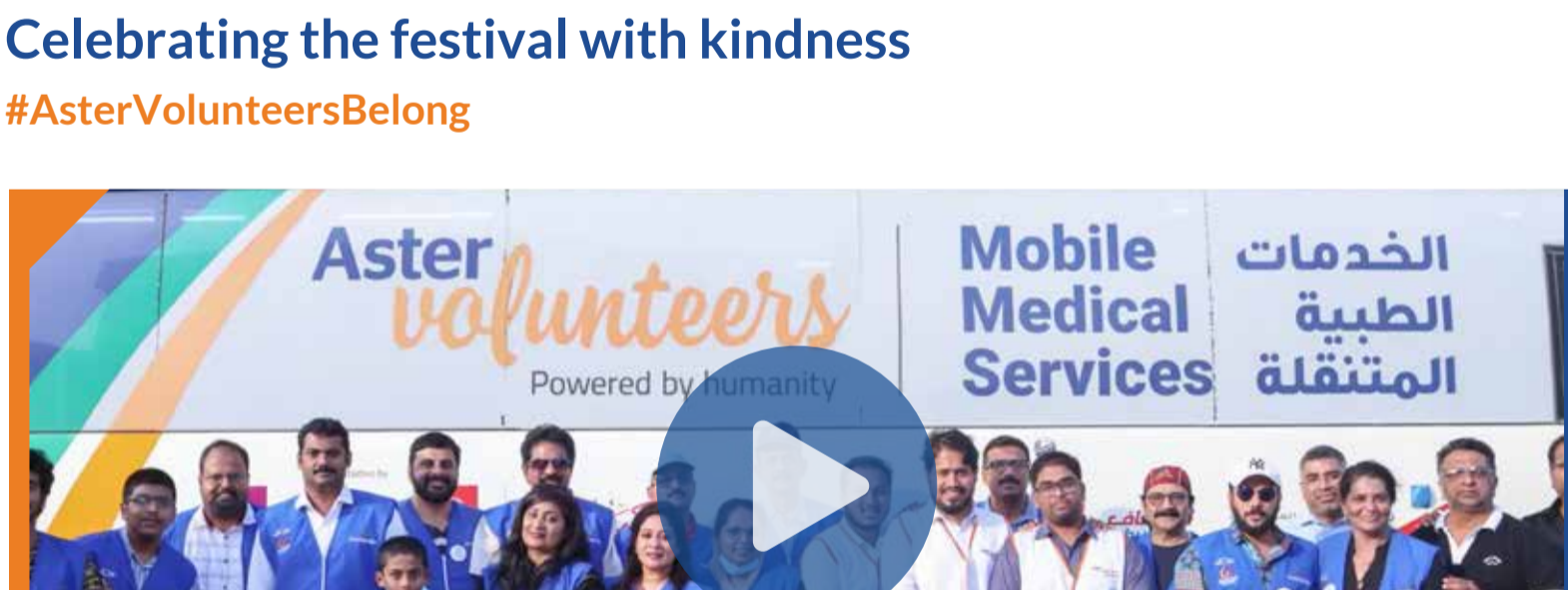
Aster Royal Hospital Muscat supported the initiative by distributing over **200 food kits** for five continuous days at Hilal & C ring signals, Doha, Qatar



Aster Sanad Hospital and Aster Volunteers distributed hundreds of Iftar kits to traveling people in different locations of Riyadh



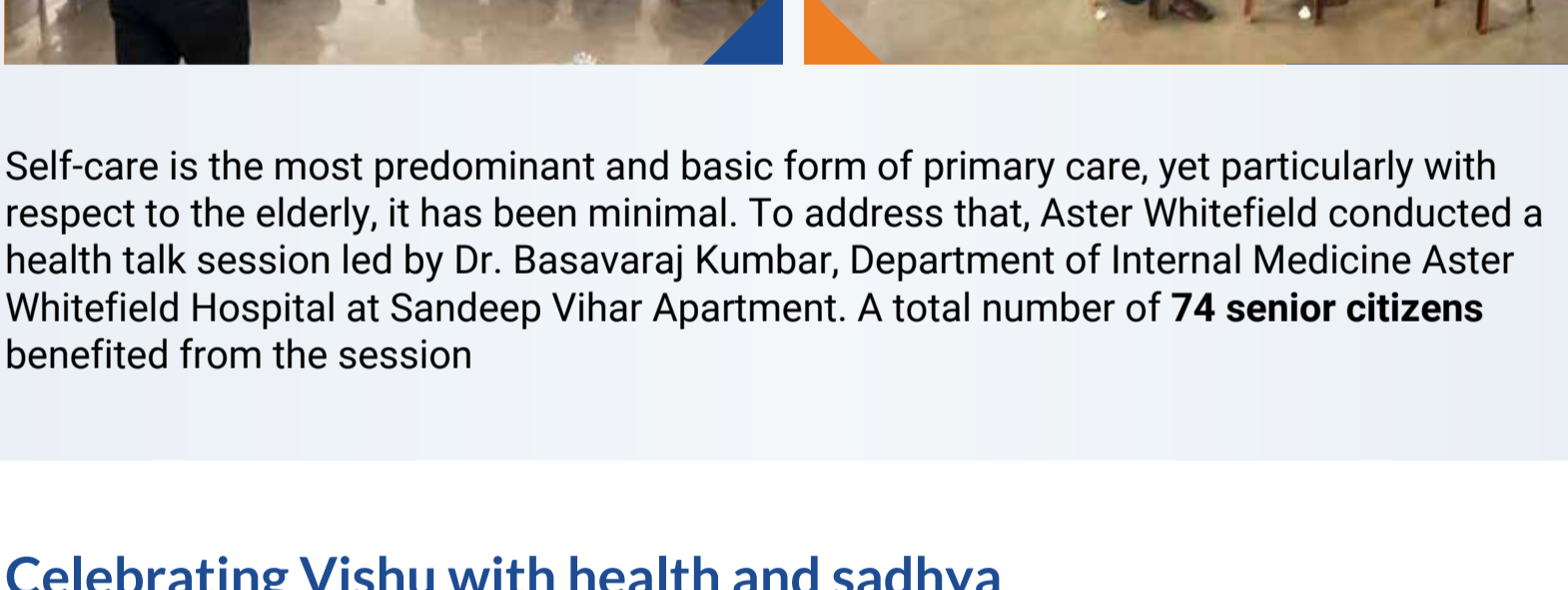
Aster Volunteers Wayanad along with Dr. Moopen's Family Foundation distributed over **600 food kits** to the poorest and needy people of Wayanad

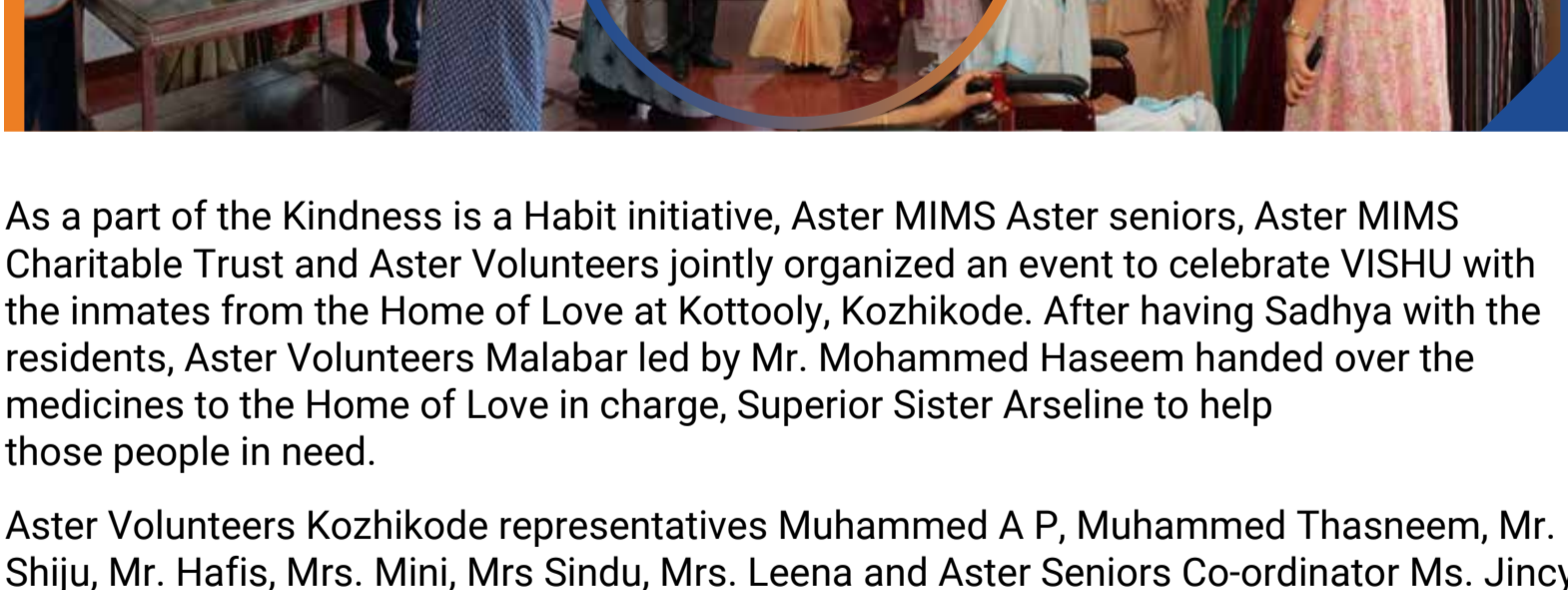
