MoU signed with the Consulate General of Sudan for providing subsidised treatment to the Sudan community in the UAE at Aster Hospitals #AsterVolunteersBelong



Under the visionary leadership of Dr. Azad Moopen, Aster Volunteers, the corporate social responsibility (CSR) arm of Aster DM Healthcare, has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Consulate General of Sudan in the UAE to enhance healthcare accessibility, and promote preventive healthcare practices within the Sudanese community

It also includes **complimentary multi-specialty medical screenings held monthly** for a year in collaboration with the Consulate General of Sudan in Dubai & Northern Emirates.
