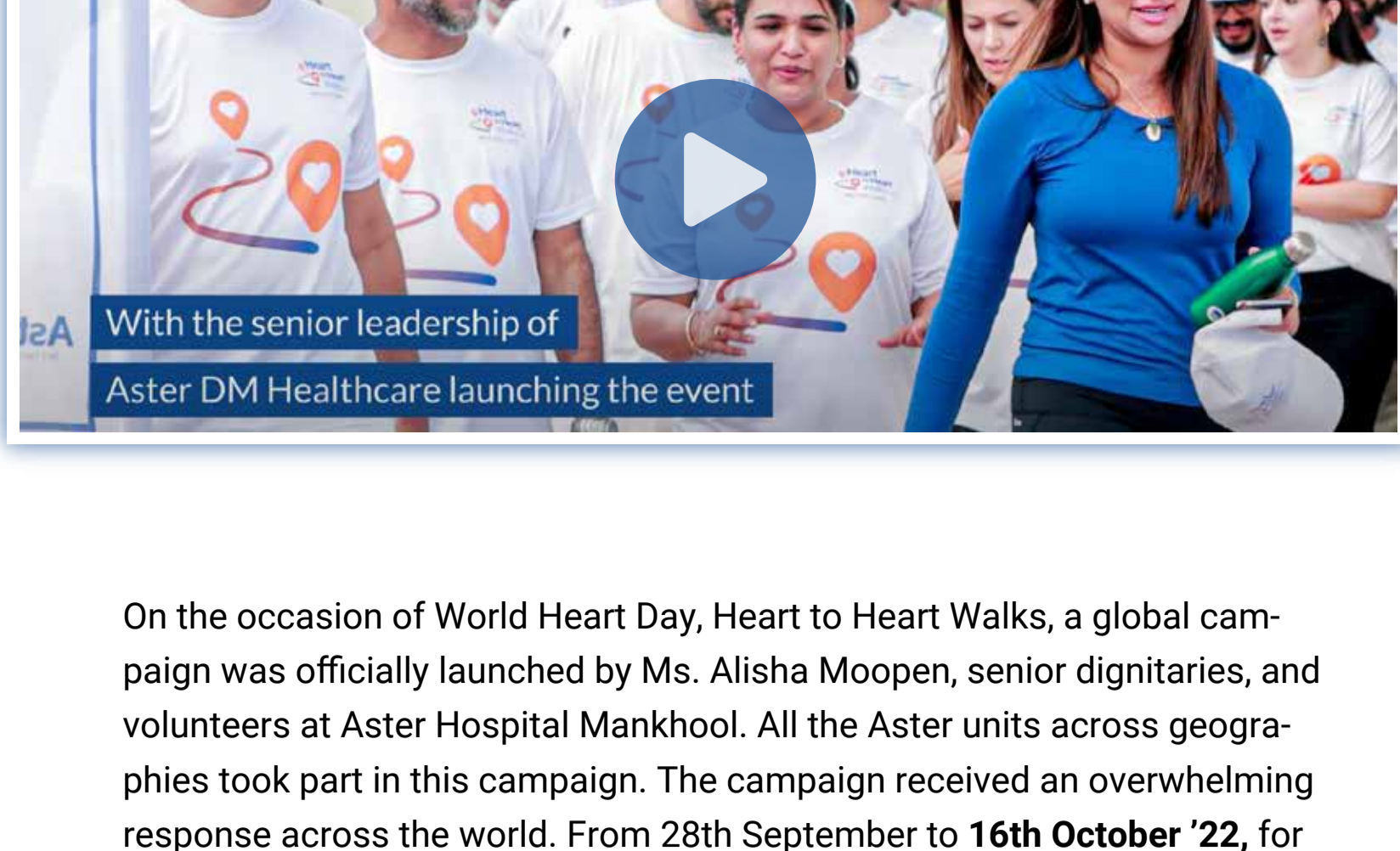




Walk for a renewed strength

With the senior leadership of Aster DM Healthcare launching the event

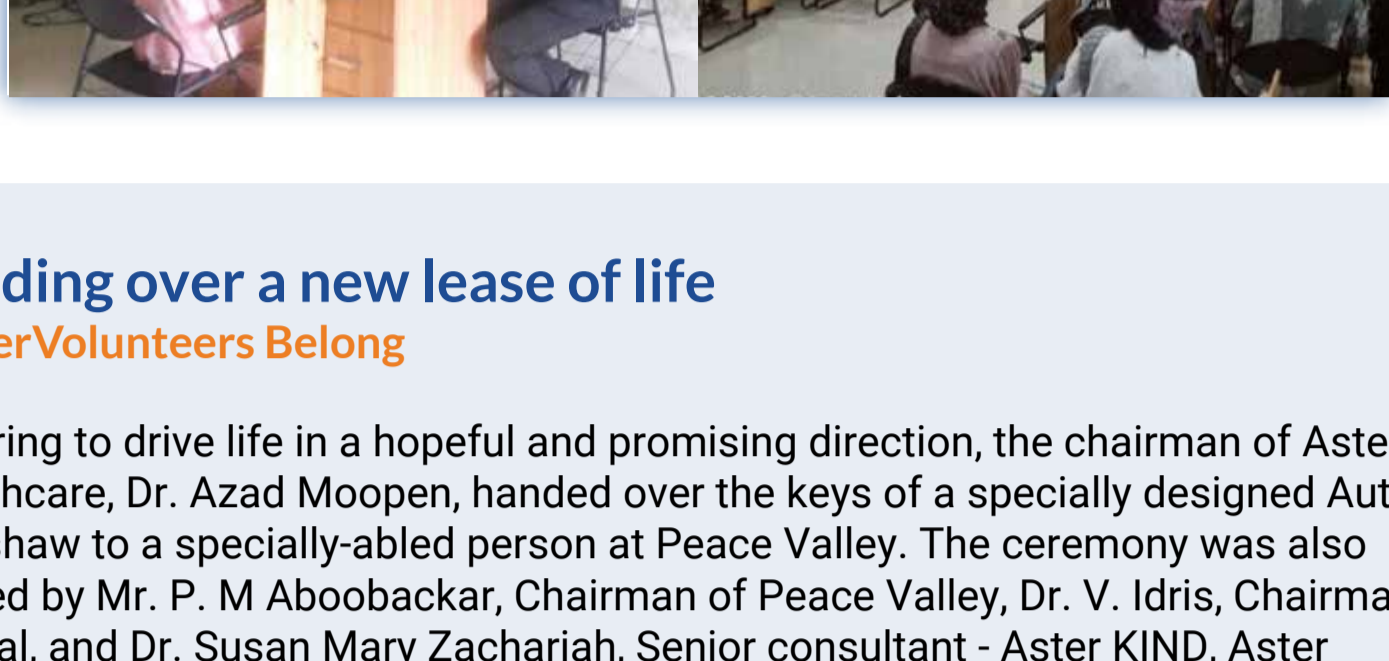

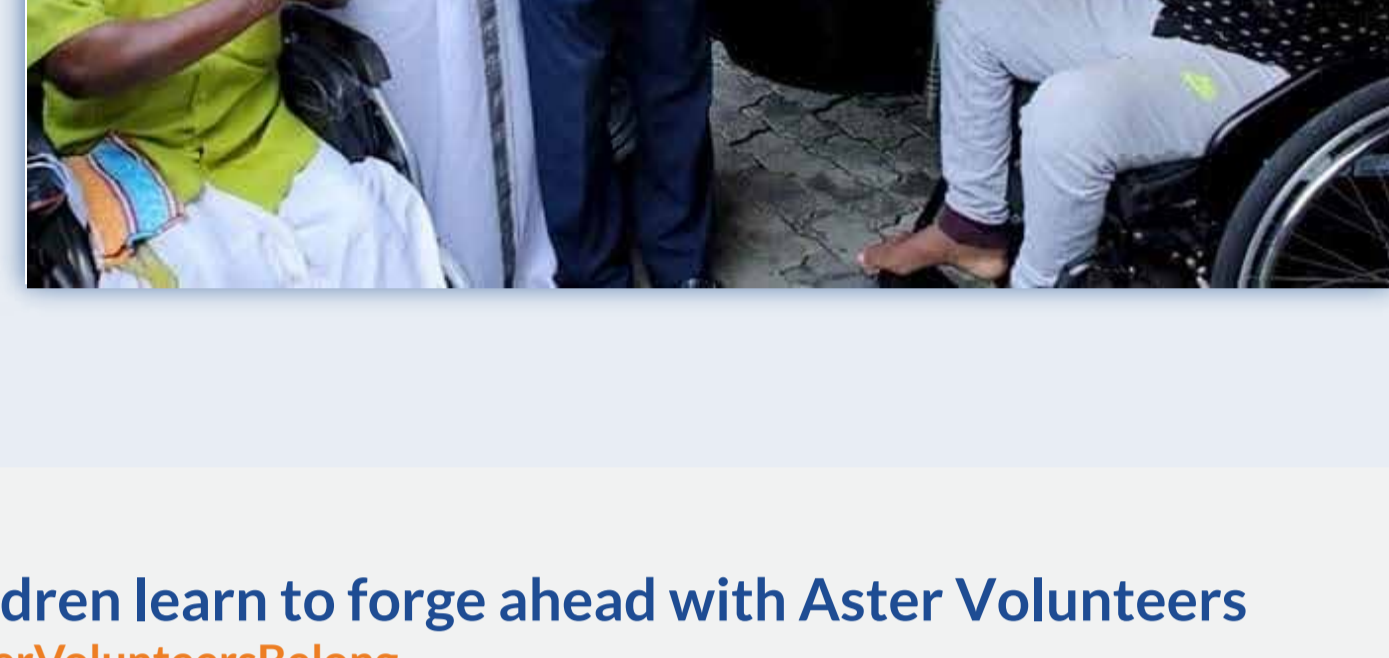

AVMMS Kochi

Aster Volunteers Mobile Medical Services Kochi conducted a free multi-specialty pediatric screening camp with the support of ASK (Aster Sick Kids) Foundation in association with Aster Medcity and Peace Valley Foundation. The camp which focused on Brain Tumors, Pediatric Cardiac Surgery, and Orthopedics benefited a total of 34 children, from which 2 heart related and 4 orthopedic cases were referred for further surgeries. 6 cases were referred to detailed screening with the support of ASK.

AVMMS Kaithal

Aster Volunteers Mobile Medical Services conducted a Health Awareness Campaign for the people of Kaithal at Balmiki Basti School and Ramanath Dera Village. The camps saw over XXXX beneficiaries from the district.
