Aster Volunteers, ASK Foundation, Peace Valley, and Aster Medcity associated with the Kerala State Forest Department to conduct 5 days of intensive medical support camps at Palakkad District. The event provided basic health screening, free medicine, malnutrition awareness, and nutritional supplementary medicines to the children and adults from the tribal communities. A total of 515 beneficiaries from the colonies at Orambadi, Kalchadi, Thalikkakallu, Meera Floors, Pulayan Para, and Pullukadu benefitted from the medical camp.

Furthermore, an external volunteer who chose not to disclose his name delivered clothes and footwear to the students from the Thalikkakallu Tribal School. We extend our gratitude to the benefactor for this noble gesture. Also, as per the request from the authorities, we wish to continue the mission on a quarterly basis to maintain health and stability in the tribal population.

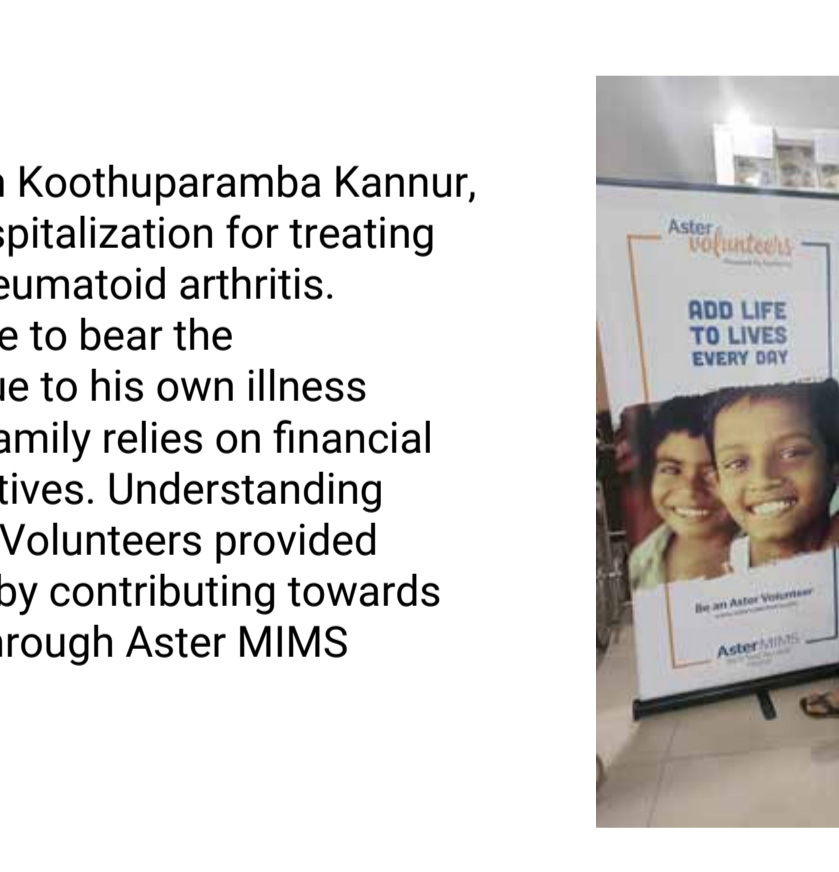

His father was unable to bear the medical expenses due to his own illness (Brain Tumor). The family relies on financial assistance from relatives. Understanding their situation, Aster Volunteers provided financial assistance by contributing towards the treatment cost through Aster MIMS Charitable Trust.

Ms Fathima

Ms. Fathima Sana K.G, 16 year old girl from the interior parts of Kodungallur, Thrissur District was suffering from a cyst in the kidney. Her father, a painter and the sole breadwinner of the family was finding it difficult to contrive finances for her treatment cost. Through the Aster Allana initiative, Aster DM Foundation supported the girl and her family by extending a major part of the treatment cost.
