

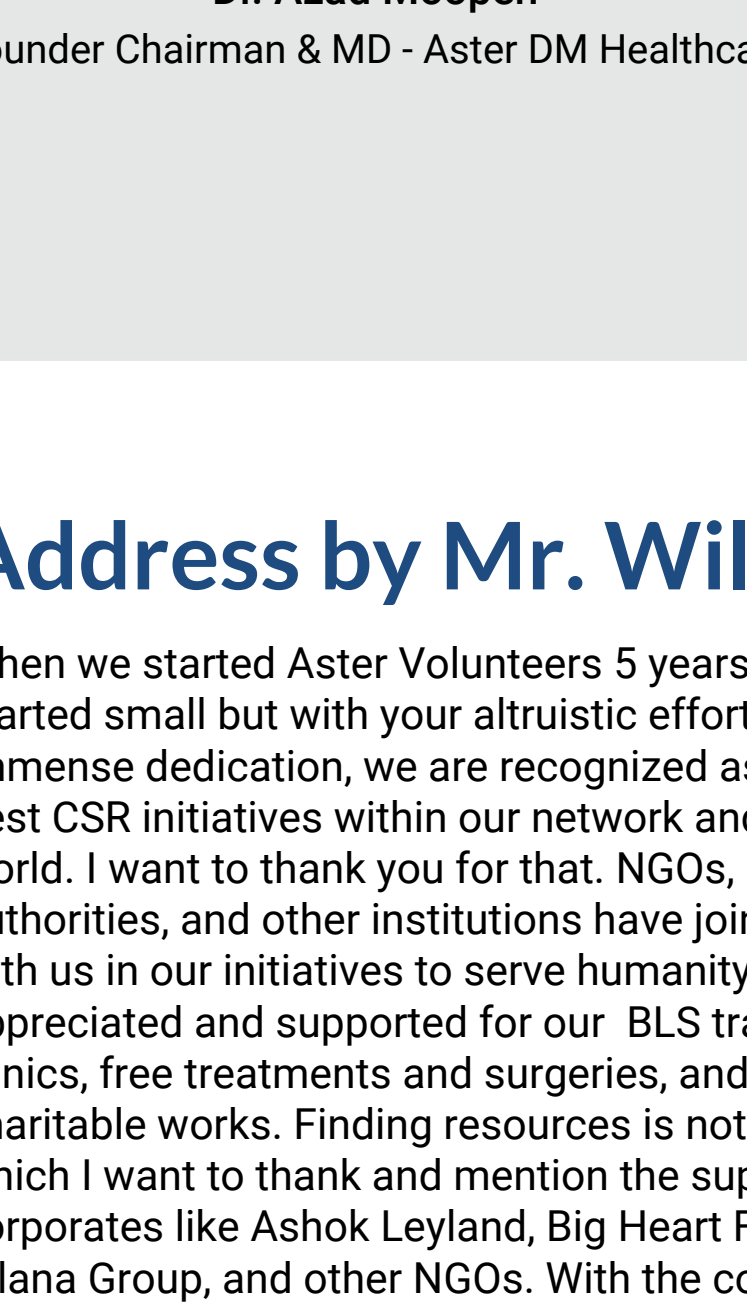

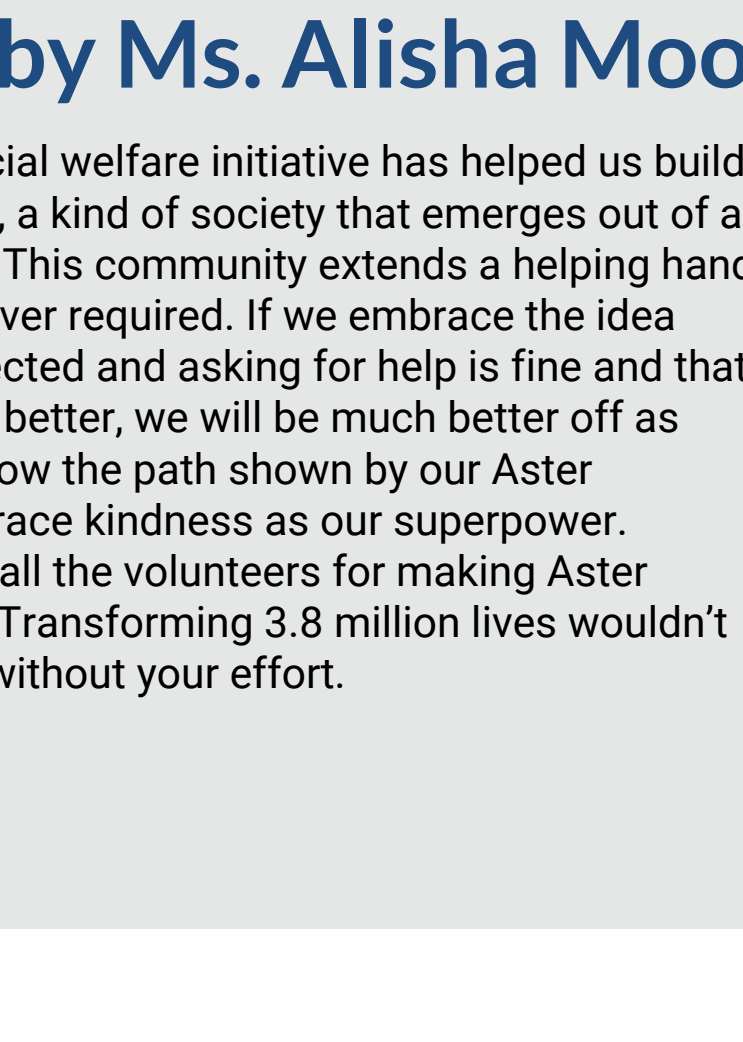

On this note, I again want to congratulate the entire leadership team and Aster Volunteers ground team for always being at the forefront and extending their arms to help and support those in need.

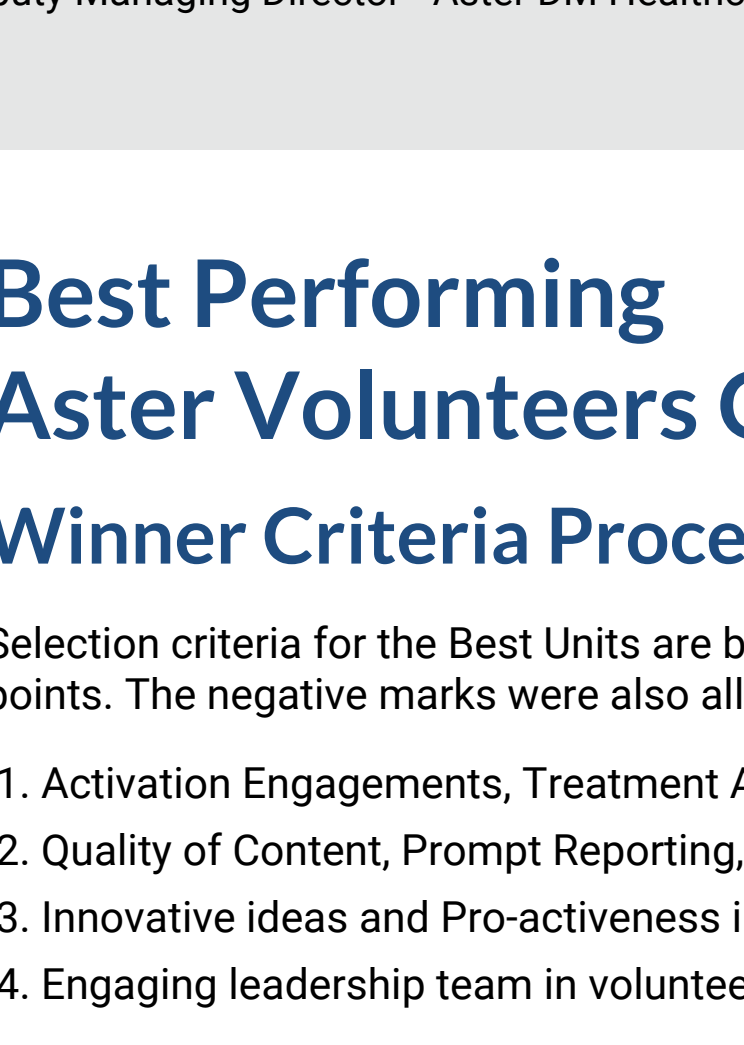
Address by Mr. Wilson

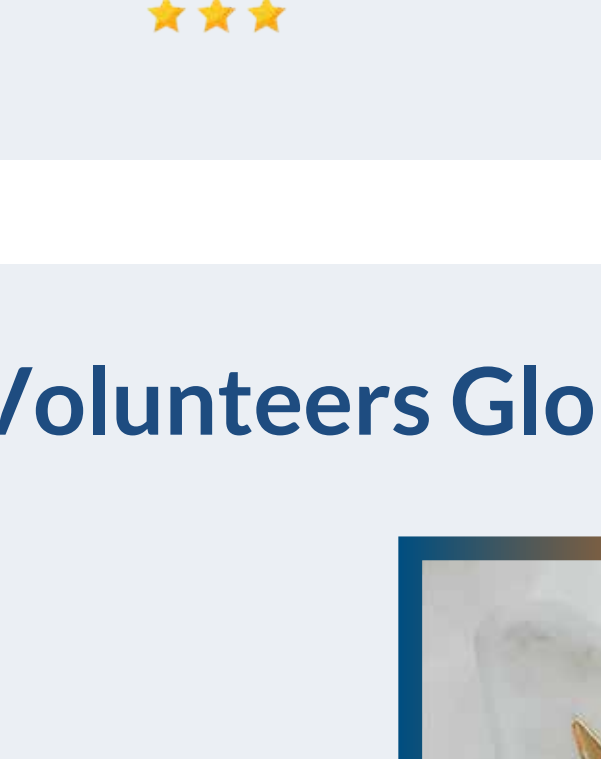

Winner Criteria Process

Selection criteria for the Best Units are based upon four important factors, each fetching 25% of the total points. The negative marks were also allotted for ineffective utilization of their potential and resources.

1. Activation Engagements, Treatment Aid and Beneficiaries in ABCD buckets,
2. Quality of Content, Prompt Reporting, and Active Participation
3. Innovative ideas and Pro-activeness in program execution
4. Engaging leadership team in volunteering, engaging functional heads, Team for Volunteering



Best Performing Unit Aster Volunteers Mobile Medical Services Units

Selection criteria for Aster Volunteer Mobile Medical Services Unit based upon important factors such as total number of camps conducted, total number of beneficiaries in the year, average number of camps and beneficiaries in a month, and also rating their new partnership, pandemic care, referrals to business units and engagement in disaster and 12 other parameters in total which directly impacted their 0-5 star ratings based on their contributions to humanitarian work. The negative marks were also allotted for ineffective utilization of their potential and resources.

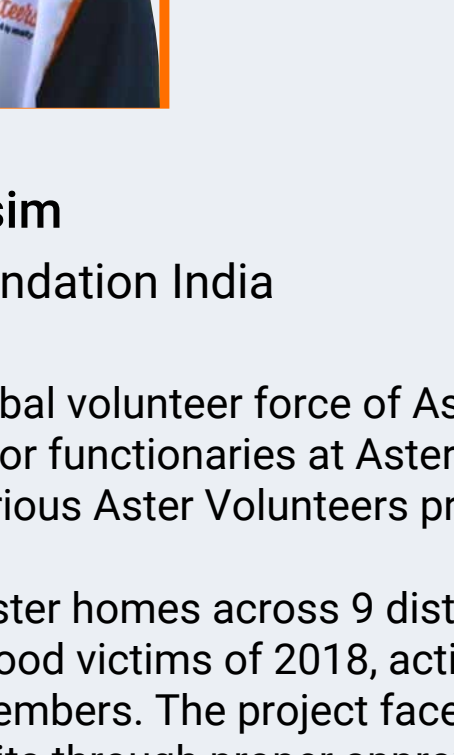

Aster Volunteer Special Jury Award



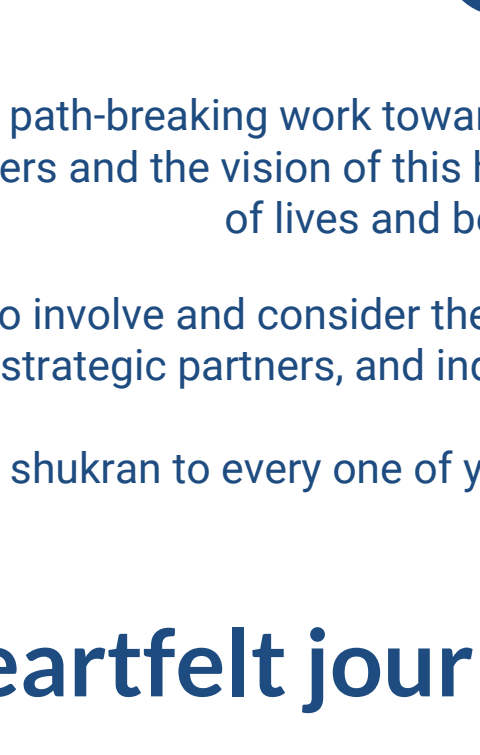

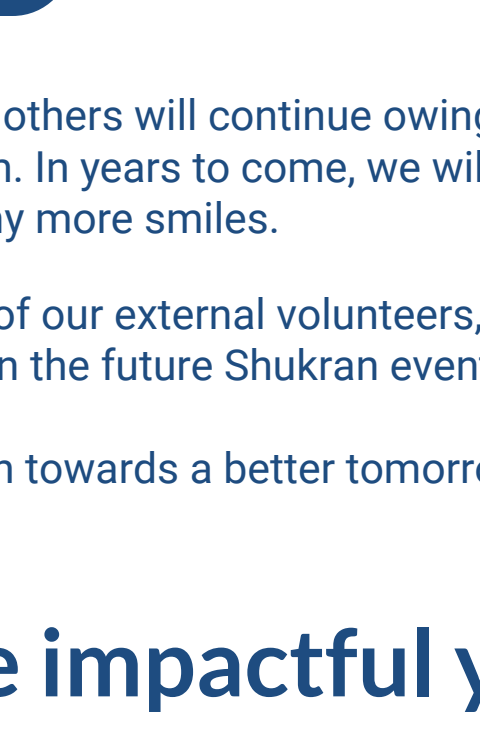
